**All race entries : \$75 per race**

(boat levies for all competing boats will be paid from entry monies)

Competitors can enter each of the following: Marathon, Age Class, Open Class, Social and Engine Classes. **Any entries submitted for ineligible classes won't be accepted. You are only eligible to enter your current age class.**

All entries are to be paid when submitted. Any entries that are unpaid will not be included in the draw and will be placed at the end of the field.

#### **Presentation**

#### **Program Of Events**

### **60/70mph Classes**

If you have a 60/70mph membership (which only allows you to run these classes plus a marathon), please submit your entry and I will arrange a race placement for you.

### **Helpers**

Each team must nominate a helper to assist for a 3 race session each day. This person must be available for 3 races in a row and a roster will be sent out prior to the event. Entries without a helper will not be accepted.

### **Fuel**

As per SRA rules, no refuelling will be permitted on the water. There are refuelling breaks scheduled in the race format, but you need to refuel at a different time you will need to come and see the Race Controller.

### **Compulsory Briefing**

Briefing for both Speed and Marathon events will be held at the race control area on the riverbank on both Saturday and Sunday commencing 7.00am each day. (please note the earlier time)

All Drivers and Observers who are competing at these Championships MUST attend these briefing sessions. A Briefing Sheet will be available for all Drivers and Observers who attend this briefing. Drivers and Observers must sign the briefing sheet.

If you cannot attend these sessions, you will need to be briefed individually in the official enclosure at the convenience of officials on duty. You will not be allowed to compete at these Championships unless you have been briefed and signed for a Briefing Sheet.

### **Start Time**

8.00am each day.

### **Park Facilities**

### **Scrutineering**
